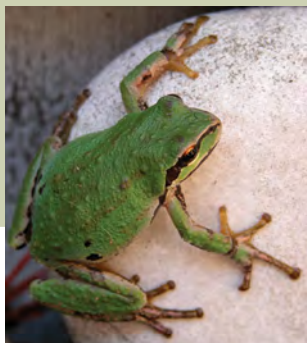
Trust Adds Land to Four More Conservation Areas



Utopia - A place for fish, frogs and farming

In May the Skagit Land Trust added the 43-acre Bishop property (picture above) to our Utopia Conservation Area on the Skagit River east of Sedro-Woolley. We'll plant native trees along the river to enhance fish habitat and we will maintain pasture land for farming. Utopia funding and restoration partners include the Salmon Recovery Funding Board, Skagit Watershed Council, Seattle City Light, Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group and Puget Sound Energy.

I was cc'ed on this email the other day;

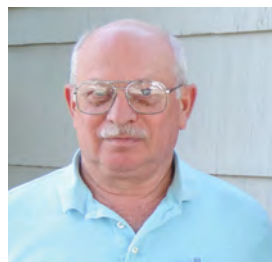
Michael and Regina,

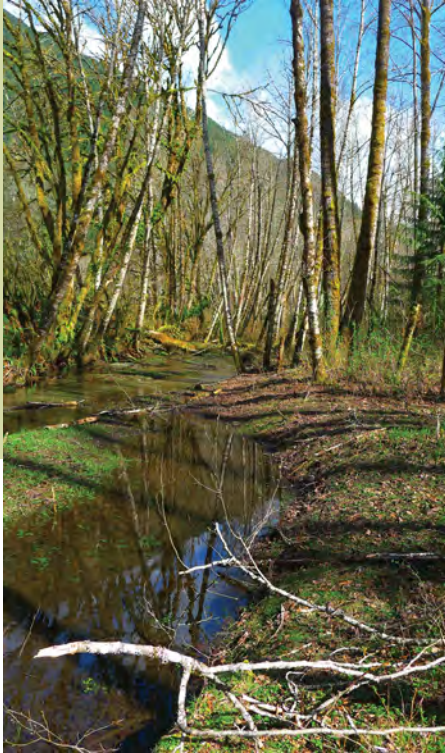

Cascade River - keeping it wild!

This purchase in January joins a Trust - owned property to the beautiful Keller - Karlberg conservation easement on the Cascade River. The property purchase was made possible by funds from Washington State's Salmon Recovery Funding Board and Seattle City Light match.

Hurn Field - The field that keeps on growing in size and popularity. Not only did we add 10.5 acres to this conservation area in March but Cascadia Weekly readers voted it the best stop on the gateway of the North Cascades Highway. The Hurn Field Conservation Area now encompasses 111 acres and connects to other protected lands serving as a sanctuary for fish, elk, songbirds and other wildlife.

Citizen Scientists Help us Understand Amphibians and Herons

It has been a busy spring at Skagit Land Trust with two monitoring programs.

Amphibian Monitoring

During March, April and June teams of 3 to 5 volunteers headed out to seven Skagit Land Trust conservation areas in search of amphibians and their eggs. Most egg masses can be found in shallow water, attached to small sticks, or other vegetation (braces) while some float along the top of the water. Northwestern Salamander, Red Legged Frog, Pacific Tree Frog and Long-Toed Salamander are among the more common species found. The data is shared with the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife and contributes to the larger picture of amphibian range and dispersal throughout Washington. Because amphibians are sensitive to environmental pollutants, their abundance in Skagit Valley is an indicator of ecosystem health and the ecological integrity of Trust properties.

Heron Nest Count and Breeding Season Behavior Monitoring

The Trust's March Point Conservation Area and the Samish Island - Squires Conservation Easement are home to two of the largest heronries on the west coast. In December, the annual heron nest count kicked off the heron monitoring season. During March through July, dedicated groups of volunteers visited the two heron colonies weekly to observe the nesting and breeding-season behavior of the birds. The Trust heron monitoring program employs a citizen-science protocol, developed by biologist Ann Eissinger, as part of a long-term monitoring effort throughout Western Washington. Heron colonies fluctuate naturally, but protection and monitoring by the Trust and others, year after year, can inform and educate interested groups in the patterns of Great Blue Heron distribution and habitat needs. This provides data critical to the conservation of the herons.

This Festival was Frog-tastic!

The Festival of Frogs was an educational amphibian day in April. The Trust hosted the festival on its Utopia Conservation Area with partners the Skagit Fisheries Enhancement Group and North Cascades Institute. About 100 kids and adults attended and learned about amphibian monitoring, made origami frogs, viewed amphibian egg masses and learned about amphibian and salmon habitat. As a bonus, they learned how to make music with grass!

We are loving watching herons on work breaks and you can too! Thanks to a project initiated in 2006 with the help of a Leadership Skagit Team, thousands of people enjoy and learn from a remote heron "cam". During nesting season from March to August the heron cam beams live images from the Trust's March Point Heronry to Padilla Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve Interpretive Center. Last year, when the initial project camera's functionality diminished, after seven successful years, grants from the D.V. and Ida J. McEachern Charitable Trust, Shell Puget Sound Refinery, The Mountaineers Foundation, The Nysether Family Foundation and help from several volunteers enabled Skagit Land Trust to complete necessary upgrades to this wildlife camera system. It now continues to beam remote images of nesting behaviors in the West Coast's largest heron colony to the Padilla Bay Interpretive Center and online at padillabay.gov/education_heron.html and skagitlandtrust.org. What is GIS?

GIS is short for Geographic Information System. This is a computer software tool that combines database and mapping technologies. It's 2/3rds Information Systems (data and other information) and 1/3rd Maps. Basically it's asking questions about some phenomena of the landscape, using a computer to do an analysis, and as needed mapping the results

• How is GIS Changing Land Conservation?

We are taking lots of science, transforming the way the information is used and presented, and transferring it to people by way of maps and other means. This helps us make more informed decisions. More information about a specific place is getting out to others. In the past a lay person would have to read a 300 page document to get that same information. Now, we can make that information more accessible. However, the caveat is that we (the technicians) still need to read the 300-page document so we know what the data means.

• How Does Skagit Land Trust Use GIS?

We use GIS in our Conservation Strategy, which is how we prioritize which types of land are most at risk and in need of protection. GIS helps us focus our efforts where we can do the most good and evaluate potential projects.

• What Are Some of the Biggest Surprises?

GIS is excellent for showing big trends and putting it in picture form. Plus it is up datable. However the quality and depth of information is not consistent, especially at smaller scales. A lot more can be done from the computer than a decade ago, but ultimately we still need to put on the gum boots and do some ground truthing.
